\* AFFIRMATION OF FAITH

*Westminster Larger Catechism*

MINISTER: How was Christ exalted in his ascension? Q53

PEOPLE: **Christ was exalted in his ascension, in that forty days after his resurrection, he, in our human nature and as our head, and triumphing over his and our enemies, visibly went up into the highest heavens. There he received gifts for men, and is preparing a place for us. Our affections are now raised upwards to heaven where He shall remain until his second coming at the end of the world.**

MINISTER: How does Christ make intercession for us? Q55

PEOPLE: **Christ in his humanity intercedes continually before the Father in heaven for us, through the merit of his obedience and sacrifice on earth. He petitions for his will to be applied to all believers. He answers all accusations against us, procuring for us peace of conscience, (and this despite our daily failings), grants us access with boldness to the throne of grace, and merits GOD's acceptance of us and our acts of obedience.**

# GOD RENEWS US IN CHRIST

CONFESSION OF SIN

EXODUS 20:3-17

MINISTER: Romans 3:20 teaches, *“Through the law comes the knowledge of sin.”* And the Apostle Paul also testifies, *“I would not have come to know sin except through the law”*<sup>1</sup>. Thus the law shows us our sin and consequently our need of Christ. Let us then read the Ten Commandments so that we might see our sin, and thereby our need of Christ for salvation. <sup>1</sup>Rom. 7:7

PEOPLE: **You shall have no other gods before me.**

**You shall not make for yourself a carved image, or any likeness of anything that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath.**

**You shall not take the name of the Lord your God in vain.**

**You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor.**
