MINISTER: What is Sanctification? Q75

PEOPLE: **We believe that sanctification is a work of God's grace, whereby we whom God has chosen to be holy from before the foundation of the world, are over time, and through the powerful operation of the Holy Spirit, renewed in our whole being into the image of God.**

God accomplishes this work, by applying the death and resurrection of Christ to us, and in this way He renews our whole being after the image of God. In addition he places in our hearts the seeds of repentance unto life, along with other saving works of grace.

**God then stirs up, increases, and strengthens these saving graces in us, such that we more and more die to sin, and rise to newness of life.**
